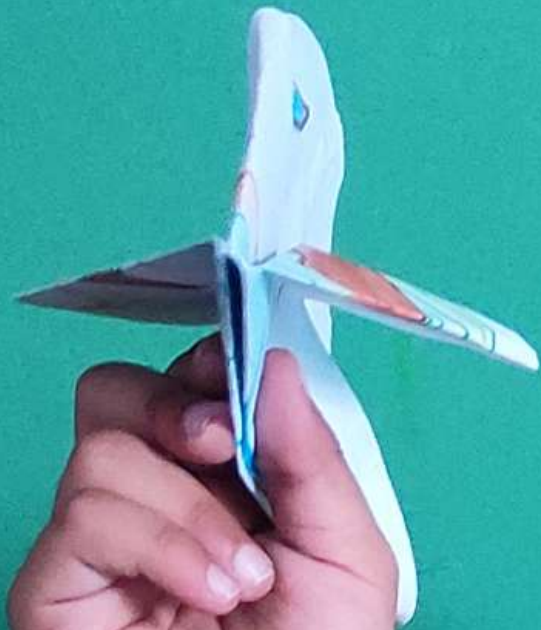

A world where people live in dignity and security and there are equal opportunities for all.

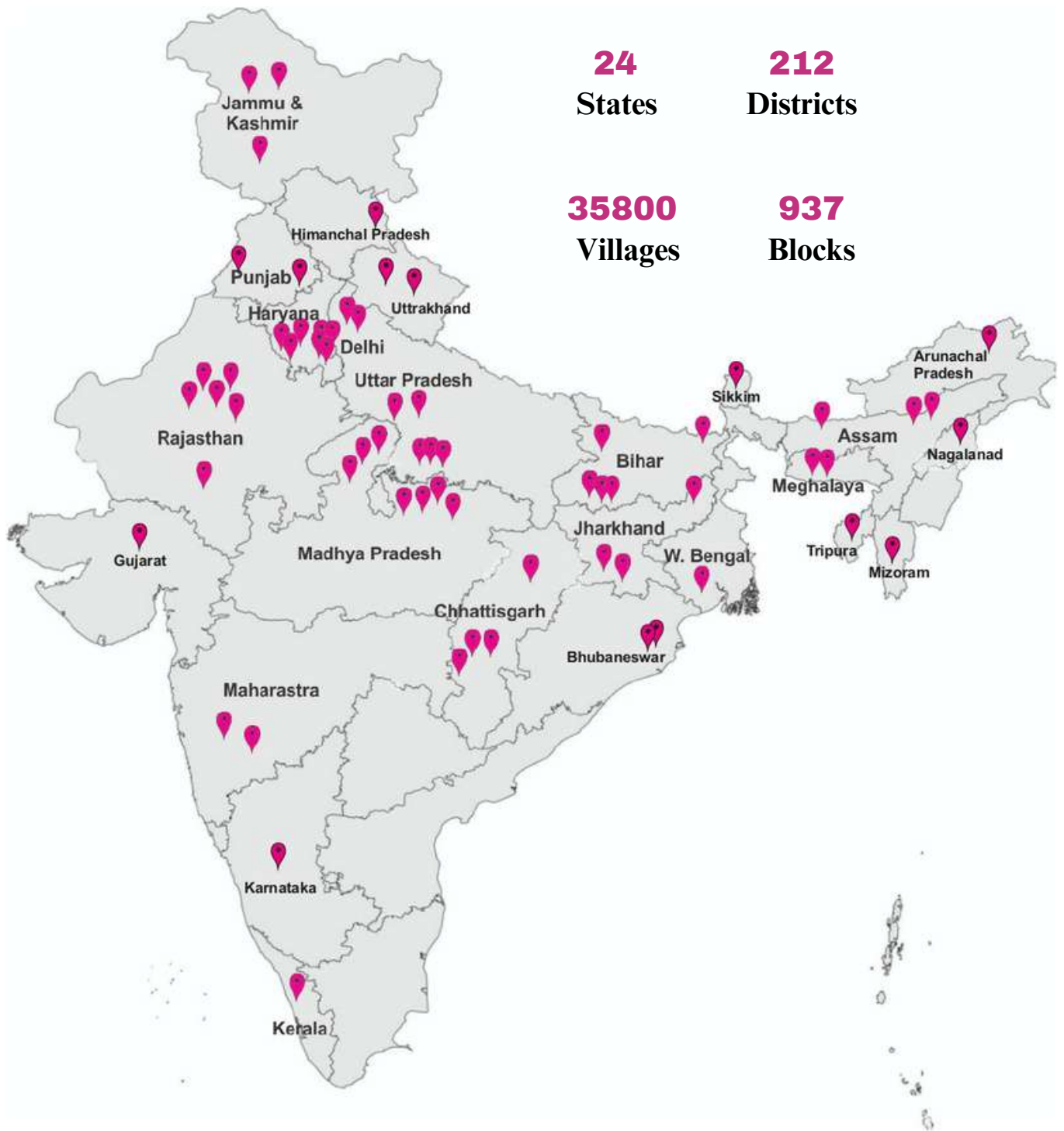

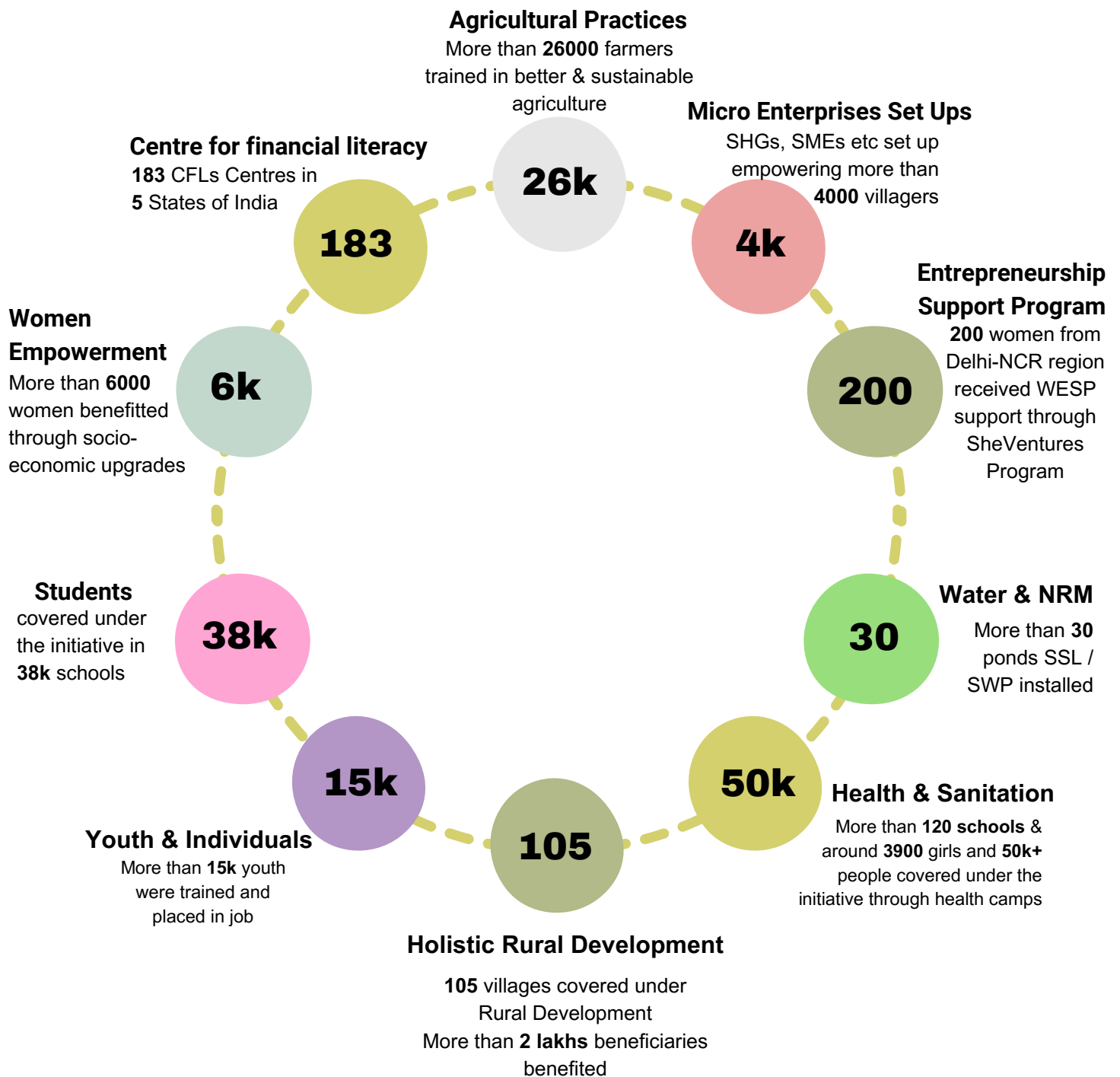

Education



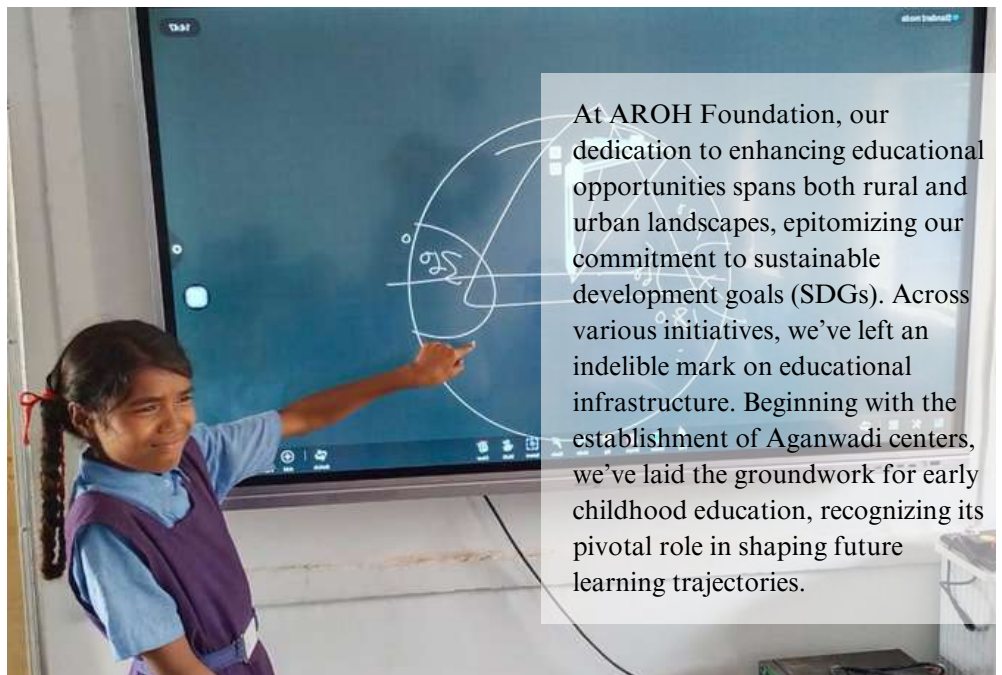

At AROH Foundation, our dedication to enhancing educational opportunities spans both rural and urban landscapes, epitomizing our commitment to sustainable development goals (SDGs). Across various initiatives, we've left an indelible mark on educational infrastructure. Beginning with the establishment of Aganwadi centers, we've laid the groundwork for early childhood education, recognizing its pivotal role in shaping future learning trajectories.



In response to the challenges posed by the pandemic, we swiftly transitioned our remedial education project RISE to an online teaching and learning mode, ensuring continuity in education for approximately 1000 children from Delhi-NCR slums. This adaptability underscores our commitment to inclusivity and resilience in the face of adversity.

Additionally, collaborations with organizations like STEM learning to establish mini-Science labs and provide teacher training further amplify our impact, aligning closely with SDG 4 (Quality Education). Through these multifaceted interventions, AROH Foundation continues to be a beacon of hope, catalysing positive change in educational landscapes and nurturing a generation empowered to realize their full potential.

Health & Sanitation



Access to adequate healthcare and sanitation stands as a cornerstone of societal well-being and progress, impacting communities from the bustling urban centers to the remotest rural villages. In recognizing the profound significance of these fundamental necessities, efforts are essential to ensure equitable access for all. Ensuring widespread access to healthcare and sanitation facilities remains imperative for fostering resilient and thriving communities. By addressing these critical needs, communities can mitigate the burdens of illness, enhance educational outcomes, and cultivate environments conducive to sustainable growth. Thus, prioritizing initiatives that bridge these gaps is not only a matter of individual health but also a catalyst for broader societal advancement, laying the foundation for a healthier, more prosperous future for all.



AROH's commitment to improving healthcare accessibility spans across 24 states in India, ensuring that every individual, regardless of their location, has access to essential medical amenities and healthcare facilities. Through a comprehensive approach, AROH organizes Health Camps and Eye check-up camps, providing crucial medical services directly to communities. Additionally, distributing basic medicines and raising awareness through campaigns are instrumental in promoting preventive healthcare practices. AROH's efforts extend beyond medical care to address menstrual health, distributing sanitary pads to adult girls and establishing sanitary units in government schools, promoting hygiene and dignity among young girls.

Moreover, AROH also focuses on enhancing infrastructure to support healthcare delivery, such as providing water coolers, solar-based water stations (Jal Minars), and drinking water stations in schools. These interventions not only ensure access to clean drinking water but also contribute to overall hygiene and well-being. By collaborating with various partners and funders, AROH endeavors to achieve Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 3 and 6, targeting improved health and sanitation for rural populations in India. In the year 2023 AROH also extends support to government hospitals by providing essential machines like X-ray radiation machines and facilitating infrastructural development for Public Health Centers, bolstering the capacity of the healthcare system to serve communities effectively. Through these multifaceted interventions, we aim to make significant strides towards ensuring universal access to healthcare and sanitation.





Natural Resource Management

“The Natural world is an incredible wonders that inspire us all. It underpins our economy, our society, indeed our very existence. Our forests, rivers, oceans and soils provide us with the food we eat, the air we breathe, the water we irrigate our crops with. We are relying on them for numerous other goods and services we depend on for our health, happiness and prosperity. These natural assets are often called the world’s ‘natural capital’. These benefits are also hugely important to the economy – from farming and forestry to leisure and tourism. If we vaguely add them up, the total value of these benefits is phenomenal – at least US\$125 Trillion every year.



Taking some quick actions towards Water and Natural Resource Management, AROH has rejuvenated 100-acre ponds, renovated damaged check Dams & Rain Water Harvesting systems, created Farm ponds and promoted low & medium water consuming farming techniques like Sprinkler, Drip Irrigation, Flood Water bunding etc. In addition to this, taking a quick action towards Climate Action, many initiatives like installation of Solar Run Water pumps, Solar Street Lights, Solar Home Lights, Farming & kitchen Gardens with organic methods of production. Ecological balance is also ensured with Pond Watering, Plantation drives, creation of Green Belts, recycling animal waste etc. All these interventions are intended for enhancing water & oxygen footprints and reducing carbon footprints.

Access to clean water

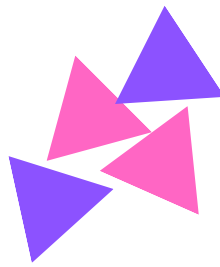
The establishment of Jal Minars by the AROH Foundation across various states in India has significantly transformed rural communities by providing reliable access to clean drinking water. These solar-powered water pumps have not only alleviated the burden of water scarcity but also reduced the time and effort women and children spend fetching water, allowing them more opportunities for education and livelihood activities. The availability of clean water has improved health outcomes, reduced water-borne diseases, and enhanced overall quality of life. Moreover, these sustainable initiatives have fostered community empowerment and resilience, promoting environmental stewardship and supporting long-term development. By leveraging renewable energy, Jal Minars underscore the importance of sustainable solutions in addressing critical rural challenges.



Rain Water Harvesting

Implementing rainwater harvesting in hill areas is crucial for addressing water scarcity by capturing and storing rainfall, ensuring a reliable water supply during dry periods. This practice supports sustainable agriculture, enhances groundwater recharge, and reduces soil erosion, fostering environmental stability and resilience in these ecologically sensitive regions.

SheVentures, a flagship initiative under the Women Entrepreneurship Support Program (WESP), is a collaborative effort between **AROH Foundation** and **FIS Global**, launched on **July 4, 2023**, at the India Habitat Centre. The program is dedicated to nurturing aspiring female entrepreneurs by providing comprehensive training on business planning, marketing strategies, and financial management, along with expert mentorship to develop essential entrepreneurial skills. Additionally, SheVentures offers access to funding opportunities through organized pitch events and networking sessions, empowering women to turn their business ideas into reality.

Skill Development & Livelihood

As India targets to becoming a global economic powerhouse, it needs equip its workforce with employable skills and knowledge to be a developed economy. AROH Foundation has concerted with Government of India's effort towards skilling of youth for past two decades and has worked diligently to address the issue in a Comprehensive manner through its multiple interventions towards skilling, health and education of youth. By acquiring relevant skills and gaining access to viable livelihood opportunities, individuals can break the cycle of poverty, build resilience against economic shocks, and foster inclusive growth.



AROH Foundation's commitment to skill development and livelihood enhancement is reflected in its diverse array of initiatives aimed at empowering individuals across various sectors and communities. Through the establishment of Micro-Enterprises and the provision of necessary equipment and support, AROH enables individuals to cultivate entrepreneurship and self-reliance. Moreover, initiatives like imparting Organic Farming Techniques, including Tressil farming and Vermi-Compost utilization, equip farmers with sustainable agricultural practices, promoting environmental stewardship and enhancing agricultural productivity. In addition, AROH's establishment of PRENA Centers for women facilitates the enhancement of knitting skills, empowering women to generate income and achieve economic independence. Handicraft and Handloom centers in Meghalaya further bolster livelihood opportunities for local artisans and marginalized women, preserving traditional crafts and fostering economic resilience. AROH's also focus on promoting organic farming methods through training and distribution of Agricultural Tools underscores its commitment to sustainable livelihoods and environmental sustainability.



HANDLOOM CENTRE

Weaving dignified futures...

The Handloom Unit under PARIVARTAN in West Jaintia, Meghalaya, empowers over 50 women by providing stable incomes through traditional weaving. This initiative preserves cultural heritage, enhances community cohesion, and connects artisans to broader markets, promoting sustainable practices and improving their quality of life. 30 members from two villages were identified & supported with raw materials & equipment's. A Centre for each village was also developed for their daily activities & storage of their finished goods. AROH foundation had supported the enterprise by helping them with 60 days weaving training for the sustainability of this intervention. Regular monitoring & other handholding support is also being provided for the success of this business. This intervention aims to enhance livelihood of small-scale household product makers such that they take up & sustain this enterprise and hence enhancement their livelihood.

BROOM MAKING UNIT

Newly established center ensuring Livelihood, Revenue & Value Chain systems

10 SHGs were identified & supported with raw materials & equipment's. A Centre was developed for their daily activities & storage of their finished goods. AROH foundation had supported the enterprise by helping them with business planning, broom making training for the sustainability of this intervention. Regular monitoring & other handholding support is also being provided for the success of this business. This intervention aims to enhance livelihood of small-scale household product makers such that they take up & sustain this enterprise and hence enhancement their livelihood.

Financial literacy and inclusion play pivotal roles in fostering economic empowerment and stability within communities. By equipping individuals with the knowledge and tools to make informed financial decisions and providing access to financial services, countries can promote inclusive growth and mitigate socio-economic disparities. Collaboration with institutions like the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is essential in advancing initiatives to enhance financial literacy and inclusion, particularly in the digital realm, as India transitions towards a cashless economy. Recognizing the significance of this endeavor, AROH Foundation is deeply committed to partnering with RBI and other stakeholders to promote financial literacy and inclusion initiatives across the country.



AROH Foundation's interventions under the Financial Literacy and Inclusion vertical are structured to empower individuals across various states in India ensuring they have the knowledge and tools to navigate the modern financial landscape effectively. Beginning with comprehensive village mapping and demand surveys aligned with RBI guidelines, AROH identifies areas where financial literacy is most needed. Subsequently, the organization conducts targeted financial literacy camps, including both household and mass awareness sessions, to educate communities on basic financial concepts and digital payment systems.



Moreover, AROH facilitates bank linkages for beneficiaries as part of the Strategy for Financial Inclusion National Strategy for Financial Inclusion (NSFI) 2019-24, enabling them to access formal financial services. Account opening initiatives further extend financial access while enrolment in government schemes like Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY), Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSSBY), Atal Pension Yojana (APY), and National Pension System enhances social security. Under the intervention comprehensive training programs in states such as Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Punjab, and Haryana equip beneficiaries with practical skills, including the use of UPI, NET banking, and digital banking methods fostering financial independence and resilience. Through these multifaceted interventions, AROH in collaboration with the partners is enabling economic empowerment at the grassroots level.

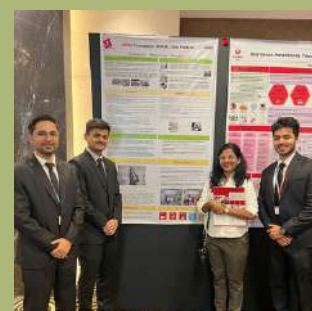
